One of the definitions of Ayurveda is that it is the science of longevity itself. However, Ayurveda has emphasised that we should not only enhance life span but health span too. The clinical speciality of Ayurveda that aims to enhance both life span and health span is known as *Rasāyana or Jarācikitsā*. Ayurveda offers a multi-pronged strategy to promote longevity and healthy ageing that includes mind-engineering, lifestyle modifications, spiritual practices, dietary regimens, herbal supplements and full-fledged treatments. On top of it all, Ayurveda also emphasises that death is an inevitable consequence of life and that every human being can consciously prepare for the end and leave the mortal body gracefully.
